The <u>Neighborhood Matching Grant</u> awards up to \$3,000 in matching grant funds to eligible recognized neighborhood organizations. The goal of the program is to facilitate neighborhood self-improvement. All projects are initiated, planned, and implemented by neighborhood members. Please read the <u>program policy</u> to see if your neighborhood's project is eligible for submission.

The application deadline is Monday, May 27, 2023, at 5 p.m.

You can help keep our city's streams healthy and litter-free by joining the Adopt-a-Stream program.

Healthy streams are an important part of our city's natural environment. They provide recreational opportunities, living and feeding grounds for fish and wildlife, flood protection, a source of drinking



water, and so much more.

When your neighborhood group enrolls in the Adopt-a-Stream program, you're committing to cleaning up your "adopted" stream segment at least twice per year. The City will provide supplies to help with your stream cleanup.

When you sign up, you also get your group's name added to a sign near your chosen stream segment. Sharing your name on the street sign is just one way we get to recognize our volunteers and all they do to help keep Concord beautiful!
