Spring Safe Disposal Event



MONTHLY TIPS

Think Before You Flush!





Sewer backups and overflows can cause major damage to your home, create health hazards, and harm the environment. One of the most common causes? Flushing the wrong items down the toilet. What should you flush?

Only toilet paper and human waste. That's it!

What NOT to flush:

- "Flushable" wipes (they aren't truly flushable!)
- Paper towels, cotton balls, swabs, and pads
- Diapers, tampons, and nursing pads
- Dental floss, hair, bandages, and wrappers
- Medications, chemicals, or motor oil
- Kitty litter and pet waste
- Needles, rags, and paint products

Even items labeled "flushable" don't break down like toilet paper and can clog pipes, damage sewer systems, and cause messy backups in your home or neighborhood.
