Sewer Allocation update

The Water Resources Director, Jeff Corley, presented a summary of requests for the December 19th 2nd Work Session Sewer Allocation meeting. He explained 167,000 gallons have been set aside in anticipation of the true up. He stated he is hopeful there will be more allocation available in March 2024.

The Council discussed what allocation amounts are remaining. Following the discussion, a motion was made by Council Member Crawford and seconded by Council Member Langford to reallocate the 436,000 gallons that was previously reserved for Red Bull—the vote: all aye.

Compensation Study discussion

The Finance Director, Jessica Jones, explained the impact the compensation totals would have on the FY24-25 budget.

The City Manager explained how the proposed mid-year increases would be funded if approved.
