E. The installation technicians must have sound experience in the field of Airport Traffic Control VCCS and systems, for not less than five years, factory trained and certified. A listing of projects, references and telephone/email contacts shall be submitted for approval.

Contractor shall provide copies of radiotelephone license of technician(s) working on, tuning and providing radio certification. Contractor shall have installation training from the manufacturer on the VCCS provided. Proof of training shall be required.

The airport has the right, for any reason, to refuse unqualified Contractors regardless of bid price.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. QUESTION: Why is the project being re-advertised?

ANSWER: The project is being re-advertised in accordance with NC General Statutes for insufficient bidders on the first bid opening.

Pursuant to Section 143-129 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, sealed bids for “Replace Air Traffic Control Tower Equipment” at the Concord-Padgett Regional Airport will be received by the City of Concord until 2:00 P.M. (*local time*) on Thursday, April 15, 2021. Immediately thereafter, the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room of the Concord-Padgett Regional Airport located at 9000 Aviation Boulevard, Concord, North Carolina 28027.

Notice is hereby given to all bidders that Executive Order 11246 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Part 21 are applicable to this contract.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or by a certified check payable to the City of Concord, Concord, North Carolina, and drawn on some bank or trust company authorized to do business in the State of North Carolina, for an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total base bid.

A performance bond and a labor and material payment bond are required.

All bids will be awarded by the Concord City Council. If applicable, the bidder shall have a City of Concord Privilege License prior to award of bid.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing time for the receipt of bids. The City of Concord reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any and all technical defects in the execution of the submission of any bid.
