City Hall Tip of the Month



Beginning July 5th, Solid Waste will no longer collect yard waste in in plastic bags and will require the use of compostable, brown paper yard waste bags or individually-owned containers for any loose yard waste.

Additionally, cardboard boxes must be placed **inside** their recycling cart. Cardboard boxes left outside on the curb **will not** be collected unless a courtesy collection has been scheduled and the boxes have been cut 3' x 3', flattened and stacked. **Courtesy collections are scheduled through Customer Care by calling 704-920-5555.**
