CITY OF CONCORD TO CONVERT INTERSECTION TO ROUNDABOUT

Project Description

the Spring and Chestnut Roundabout. Weather dependent, make access to their homes. construction will begin November 9th, 2020, with finalizations occurring approximately six months following.

Concord will have a new design proven to be more cost- Tournament Dr. SW. effective and safer than comparative intersection designs. Beginning November 9th, Managed Construction, LLC will begin converting the heavily traveled intersection into a Mini Roundabout Teardrop.

While under construction, the City of Concord Water Department will replace the water main, including installing a new water main and associated lateral lines and devices. Additional construction will include removing the existing pavement, curb, gutter, and sidewalk, allowing for the rebuilding of the road base, new curbing, guttering, and sidewalks.

Why a Mini Roundabout?

Per the Federal Highway Administration, they are often safer, more efficient, less costly and more aesthetically appealing than conventional intersection designs. Furthermore, roundabouts are an excellent choice to complement other transportation objectives - including Complete Streets, multimodal networks, and corridor access management - without compromising the ability to keep people and freight moving through our towns, cities and regions, and across the Nation.
