**CABARRUS AND STANLY COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA  
ALBEMARLE WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN  
REQUEST FOR PREQUALIFICATION INFORMATION (RFP)**

Having an opportunity to expand the panel of qualified contractors as a result of the extended timeframe following receipt of previous applications prior to bidding, applications for prequalification of bidders will be received by W.K. Dickson & Co. for the City of Concord at the W.K. Dickson Charlotte office, 616 Colonnade Drive, Charlotte, NC 28205 until 2:00 PM ET, March 27, 2013 for the Albemarle Water Transmission Main Project.

Contractors who qualified previously are not required to submit a second application.

The work will consist of two (2) separate contracts to be bid separately with the following general scope:

Contract No. 1:

Contract 1 will include a 1,000,000 gallon ground storage tank, two (2) booster pump stations, emergency generators and all necessary appurtenances for a successful project completion. Booster pump stations site work will include, but not be limited to, grading, building construction, pump skid installation, wiring, piping, landscaping, tank construction and fencing.

Contract No. 2:

Contract 2 will consist of the water transmission line and will be separated into two divisions. Contractors may bid Division 1, Division 2, or both. The total project work will consist of approximately 78,603 LF of 30 inch and 11,150 LF of 24 inch water line.

- Division I - Will consist of approximately 58,153 LF of 30 inch and 11,150 LF of 24 inch water lines along with appurtenances within Cabarrus County.
- Division II - Will consist of approximately 20,450 LF of 30 inch water lines and appurtenances within Stanly County.

Please note that only registered application holders may submit for qualification as a General Contractor.

The construction contract for the project is anticipated to bid in May 2013 and the construction period is estimated to be approximately 540 days.

The project will be bid as two (2) contracts in accordance with North Carolina General Statutes.

At the time, date and place above, Qualifications will be opened and tabulated for review and consideration. Applications received after this time will not be considered. Each applicant will be notified of the City's determination concerning prequalification in writing prior to advertising this project for bids.

Registered applicants may review construction documents in person at the W.K. Dickson Charlotte office mentioned above (704-334-5348) or electronically through the plan room. Advance appointment is required for review of documents in person.

All requests for interpretation of the RFP application requirements must be made in writing to the Engineer.

The City of Concord will not accept bids for these construction contracts from Contractors who fail to submit timely applications for prequalification or from Contractors who fail to prequalify. Contractors are requested to submit prequalification information only if they intend to bid the project.
