

FAQ for Summer Playground and Camp GoneALot

- 1) What is the fee for Summer Playground?
The fee for City of Concord residents is \$350/child. For non-city residents the fee is \$450/child. There is a \$100 deposit due at registration.
- 2) Do I get a discount if I have more than one child registering?
At this time we do not offer a discount.
- 3) How do I know if I live within the Concord city limits?
You are a resident if you reside within the City Limits of Concord. If you are still not sure please call 704-920-5600.
- 4) Where are the camps located?
Hartsell Park- 60 Hartsell School Rd. NW
Les Myers Park- 338 Lawndale Ave. SE
Caldwell Park- 362 Georgia Ave. SW
Camp GoneALot – 147 Academy Avenue, NW
- 5) What time do the playgrounds open and close?
Program hours are 7:30 am – 6:00 pm
- 6) Who are the Summer Playground leaders?
Many of our staff works in the Cabarrus County Schools.
- 7) What is the ratio of leaders to children?
1:15 (One leader for every 15 children)
- 8) Do I need to pack my child a lunch?
Bring snacks, water bottles and lunch.
Lunches will be provided at Hartsell Park, Caldwell Park, and Myers Park through the Cabarrus County Schools' Summer Nutrition Program.

Lunches are not provided at GoneALot since those campers are on the move almost daily. GoneALot campers will need to bring a lunch daily.
- 9) Are there any extra costs?
The fee includes most trips and program offerings.
