The goal of the program is to facilitate neighborhood self-improvement. All projects are initiated, planned, and implemented by neighborhood members. Please read the <u>program policy</u> to see if your neighborhood's project is eligible for submission.

The application deadline is Monday, May 27th at 5 p.m.

#### Cabarrus Ave & Union St Intersection Closing Monday for Construction



The intersection of Cabarrus Ave and Union St is scheduled to close on Monday, May 20th as part of the Downtown Concord Streetscape Project. The closure is expected to last two months, weather-dependent, while contractors work on the streetscape and update existing utilities.

During the closure, the Municipal Parking Deck will remain accessible from both the Cabarrus Ave and the Union St entrances and drivers may still use Market St to visit downtown businesses or access the city's payment drop box.

Interested in composting? We'll also share ways you can reduce waste through backyard or community composting.




#### Native Plants and Pollinators

#### **Grass Clippings Are An Overlooked Polluter!**

When it rains, grass clippings left in the street after mowing are washed into storm drains that lead directly into the closest waterway. Grass clippings can increase nutrients in water and cause algae blooms that can make the water unhealthy for people and wildlife.

Remember, only rain down the storm drain!
